

## **GDPR-compliant privacy policy**

1. The Seller is the controller of the Customer's personal data within the meaning of generally binding legislation on the Customer's personal data.

The following provisions apply unless a separate privacy policy is referenced in the sales panel.

2. Personal data, in particular name and surname, e-mail address and, where applicable, telephone number, will be processed by the Seller and duly authorised agents solely for the purpose of providing services and benefits to the Customer, enabling the exercise of the Customer's rights arising from the fulfilment of the Entry Pass, clarifying the circumstances of any use of services in breach of these Terms and Conditions or in breach of applicable law and investigating any complaints. The subject matter, scope, nature of the processing and type of personal data and the categories of persons to whom such data relate, as well as any data required by generally applicable law, are set out in Annex 1;
3. The provision of data is voluntary but necessary for the provision of services. The customer, who is the data subject, has the right to control the processed data by obtaining information about the processing of personal data, the possibility to request the completion, updating, correction of personal data, the right to submit a written request to terminate the processing of their data and to forget about them. For this purpose, the Customer should contact the Seller in writing by e-mail to the Seller's address indicated in the footer of the sales panel.
4. The Seller declares that the information systems used for the processing of personal data meet the requirements of the applicable legislation, in particular they are protected at a high level within the meaning of the Regulation of the Minister of the Interior and Public Administration of 29 April 2004 on the documentation on the processing of personal data and on the technical and organisational conditions to be met by the equipment and information systems used for the processing of personal data, and that this state of affairs will be maintained for the duration of the Contract.
5. If the customer gives his/her consent by ticking the appropriate box during the purchase, the seller may process the customer's personal data for marketing purposes and send commercial information to the customer's email address. Consent to the processing of data for marketing purposes and the sending of commercial information can be withdrawn by sending a message to the Seller's email address.
6. The Seller shall not be liable for the consequences of false or erroneous information provided by the Customer if the Customer cannot be contacted despite the Seller's due diligence.
